ITEM No. 1.4:

To revise the syllabus of certain Elective Courses.

PTU has prescribed syllabus for Mobile Application Development, Agile Software Development, and Business Intelligence under the code of BTCS902, BTCS909 & BTCS908. Department wants to revise the syllabus of these courses as per the syllabus prescribed by Infosys Ltd under the "Campus Connect" Program. The syllabus prescribed by Infosys is more towards depth of course and is practice oriented, The Syllabus, Course Outcomes and List of External Examiners for above stated subjects is placed at Annexure D (page 77 to 82). It is worth mentioning that this syllabus is being taught to the students of this department for last two years as value added subjects. It is proposed that these syllabi should replace the syllabi prescribed by PTU as stated in agenda 1.2. The subject code for these subjects shall remain same.
